REDBIRD'S GUIDED INDEPENDENT FLIGHT TRAINING SOFTWARE IS NOW AVAILABLE

The simulator-based maneuvers training supplement is designed to help student pilots achieve their goals faster.

GIFT is a simulator-based training supplement that allows a student pilot to learn, practice, and get feedback on every maneuver required for a pilot certificate, at their own pace. GIFT contains 33 modules that cover all the tasks and maneuvers required for Private Pilot training.
